

## AGNES TOURAINE CO-OPTED TO REXEL'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS

During its meeting on February 10, 2017, Rexel's Board of Directors, acting on the recommendation of its Nomination and Compensation Committee, unanimously agreed to co-opt Agnès Touraine as independent director.

Agnès Touraine replaces Marianne Culver, who stepped down from her position as director of Rexel in November 2016.

Ian Meakins, Chairman of the Board of Directors, said: "We are very pleased to welcome Agnès Touraine as a new independent Board member. Her background, rich professional experience and skillset will be strong assets to support the Group's development and the implementation of its strategy."

She holds a degree in Law, graduated from the Paris Institut d'Etudes Politiques and has an MBA from Columbia University Business School, New York.

She currently sits on the Board of Proximus and the Supervisory Board of Tarkett. She previously was non-executive director of Cable&Wireless (UK), Neopost and Darty PLC. She is also a board member of several non-profit organizations such as IDATE and the French American Foundation.
